



BURLINGHAM SPORTS

Stripes for Jump Poles are available in 8 bright beautiful colors. Silk screened to resist fading these stripes are an 8 ml. thick vinyl, which will resist the abuse of everyday use.

These stripes come 12" wide and can be cut down to any width. (3" 4" 6" etc) or double them up to make 24" stripes.

Using a straight edge mark the width you desire and make sure you are cutting along the 14" dimension. The 14" dimension is needed to wrap around the pole. Preferably cut using a straight edge and an x-acto or razor knife. If you are good with scissors they will also work.

Application:

Pole should be hanging on jump cups to allow the pole to be rotated freely.

First, before you remove the backing, wrap the stripe around the pole to select the position of the stripe. With a pencil or pen mark on the pole the starting position of the two corners of the stripe.

Make sure the pole is clean and free of dirt before application.

Although it is not necessary, it is helpful to have a helper when applying the stripes.

Remove the backing and put the corners of the stripe along the pole where you marked. Slowly work your way around the pole attaching as you go swiping with your fingers to eliminate any air bubbles that may appear. It is helpful to rotate the pole as you make your way around it. Try to make the stripe align squarely and straight as possible.

The stripe will overlap itself at least $\frac{3}{4}$ " of an inch depending on the size of the pole.

If the stripe is not square to itself and there is overlap left or right of center, then excess can be trimmed off using an x-acto or razor knife.
